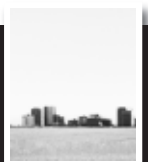

- Capital improvement – a cost incurred to improve a building or equipment that will extend its life or increase its usefulness or productivity.
- Program – costs associated with offering multiple or ongoing participation opportunities for at least one month (children's summer school, lunch program, art education program, or concert series).
- Event – costs associated with offering a participation opportunity for less than one month (music festival, art exhibit or sports competition).
