Online Application Form Overview

This is a preview of what you'll find on the online application form. We recommend you gather the information for these questions (whether nominating yourself or someone else) and work through a rough draft. It will save you time when you complete the official form online.

Who are you nominating?

We'll be asking for complete contact information for the nominee – full name, mailing address with postal code, phone numbers, email address, employer's name or business, and job title.

Tell us about the nominee

We want to know a little about the nominee's background. Share her story (where she grew up, went to school – details she'd tell someone she just met).

The short essay

In 100 words or less, describe the nominee and your reasons for choosing her. Tell us:

- How is the nominee involved in Canadian agriculture?
- How does the nominee demonstrate her commitment to agriculture?

- What kinds of agriculture-related organizations is the nominee involved in (past and present)?
- Describe how the nominee's leadership has benefited agriculture and/or rural Canada.
