FCC considers the safety of everyone at our events a top priority. Our Duty of Care is a living document that will continue to evolve as guidelines and protocols change.

FCC will follow current official government and regional guidance, as well as any venue- or location-specific rules for each event.

Attendee personal accountability commitment

All event attendees must agree to abide by and engage in certain health-and-safety-beneficial conduct while attending our events.

This includes, but is not limited to:

- Wearing a mask in public areas when required
- Engaging in appropriate physical distancing
- Not attending the event if you are:
 - Ill and are experiencing signs and symptoms of COVID-19
 - Believe you may have been recently exposed to COVID-19
 - Have been diagnosed with COVID-19 and are not yet cleared as non-contagious

Onsite protection

FCC works with the venue to ensure we maintain the highest standards of hygiene and cleanliness throughout the duration of the event.

- Hand sanitizer will be available upon arrival and positioned throughout the event space.
- Masks will be available at registration for general attendee use.
- Food safety protocols and barriers will be implemented where applicable.
- Event seating and traffic flow may be managed by use of one-way systems and strategic line queuing to ensure social distancing, regulate attendance and disperse crowding.
