

FCC vaccination requirement for vendor personnel



FCC is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for the protection of employees as well as all those who enter our offices and facilities. This commitment includes implementing measures to protect against the risk of COVID-19 transmission.

As of November 15, 2021, vendor personnel who access FCC offices must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19.

The vaccination requirement doesn't apply to:

- Contracts that are solely for the provision of goods
- Contracts where services are solely performed outside FCC premises
- Situations where FCC employees must enter a vendor's facilities (for example, to conduct compliance audits or security verifications)
- Vendor personnel who will only access common areas of buildings that are open to the public (such as a lobby)

Vendor employees include all employees, agents, consultants and contractors of the vendor and any sub-contractor engaged in the performance of the vendor's obligations to FCC.

Meeting the vaccination requirement

FCC considers vendor personnel to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 if they've received the full series of a COVID-19 vaccine or a combination of COVID-19 vaccines approved by Health Canada, and 14 days have passed since the individual received the final dose of the COVID-19 vaccine. Health Canada may change what it considers to be a full series of COVID-19 vaccinations over time.

Negative COVID tests aren't considered compliant with this requirement.
